### JOB SUMMARY:

Under the direction of the Parks Superintendent, position is responsible for specific and general maintenance for all recreation areas, primarily for mowing maintenance of various Parks, Medians, and Athletic Fields, Green spaces and large open public areas, working safely in all sections of the parks department and perform various other assigned/related duties.

### ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

1. Position involves the operation of Wide Area Mowers, Tractors with various attachments (tillers, rakes, drags, box blade, mowers, aerators, front-end buckets, augers, backhoe, and bat-winged mowers), Bucket Truck, Zero Turn mowers, etc.
2. Perform routine maintenance on the mowers, tractors.
3. Attend seminars and classes when available; related to maintenance of tractors and related equipment.
4. Responsible for equipment being fueled, greased and adjusted for day to day operations.
5. Climb a 16 foot ladder while performing tasks such as painting, pruning trees, etc.
6. Push, pull, or drag up to 200 pounds of tools or equipment.
7. Operate tractors with 60 hp and above.
8. Ability to connect trailers, load equipment on trailers, pull trailers and reverse trailers into difficult areas
9. Ensuring proper functioning of safety equipment prior to operating equipment.
10. Inspect all areas to be mowed for any obstacles, trash and debris.
11. Report any damages to trees, play equipment, benches, tables, etc. to Supervisor.
12. Report damages of all equipment, trucks, trailers, etc. to Supervisor
13. Perform litter duties as needed.
14. Available to work rotating schedules for special events, parades during weekends and Holidays.
15. Ability to operate powered, small hand tools, weed eaters, blowers, etc.
16. Ability to comprehend and follow written work orders and oral instructions.
17. Ability to work in various weather conditions.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High school diploma or GED.
2. Valid Texas commercial driver license, class C, with an acceptable driving record.
3. Previous equipment operating experience preferred.

**PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear.
