IOR SUMMARY:	

Under the direction of the Chief Operator, performs various skilled and semiskilled work in the operation, inspection, maintenance and repair of the wastewater treatment facility to comply with State and Federal permits.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Conducts facility assessments to calculate and record daily usage.
- 2. Compares readings on equipment and processes with established operational ranges to evaluate system performance. Initiates system changes within established guidelines to affect process control.
- 3. Performs preventive maintenance inspections, such as checking equipment, taking samples, adjusting operating parameters and visually inspecting processes.
- 4. Ensures plant safety and sanitary requirements:
- Washes down treatment processors
- Cleans clarifiers, intake screens, etc.
- Maintains plant grounds, i.e. collects litter
- 5. Maintains records and logs.
- 6. Coordinates the delivery of support materials, information and personnel from other departments. Assists in providing tours.
- 7. Communicates and coordinates work with other operators and support personnel by telephone and telemetry equipment.
- 8. Provides superintendents/supervisors with status reports and relays information to other affected departments.
- 9. May be assigned to the plant control room for monitoring multiple systems.
- 10. Proper use of safety equipment in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations.
- 11. Performs other duties as requested.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Requires a high school diploma or a GED certificate.
- 2. Requires a valid Texas driver's license and compliance with the City of Texas City policy on driving.

LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

1. Must possess a valid Texas Class "B" Wastewater Operator's License.
