JOB SUMMARY: Under the direct supervision of the Rangemaster, perform various jobs for the continuous operation of the Shooting Range. This position must work to promote safety in all sections of the Shooting Range, and do related work as required.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Obtain knowledge of general accounting practices including collection and receipting of monies.
- 2. Climb an 8 foot ladder while performing various maintenance duties.
- 3. Operate various hand held, push type power tools such as lawnmowers, edgers, skill saw drills, etc.
- 4. Supervise large groups including children, both visually and audibly to insure health/safety standards and the orderly integration of all programs.
- 5. Operate office equipment, calculator and telephone.
- 6. Obtain knowledge of simple first aid, CPR, and posted emergency procedures.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. High school diploma or GED.
- 2. Valid Texas driver license with an acceptable driving record.
- 3. Ability to cope with large crowds and high noise levels.
- 4. Ability to work well with others and a willingness to learn.
- 5. Lift weights up to 100 pounds.
- 6. Must be 18 years of age or older.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear.
