Residential and commercial equipment must be anchored on all 4 sides with 18 gauge strapping or with bolting.

- 1) Rooftop units must be anchored to the structure and have an external disconnect with a 110 volt outlet within 50 feet of unit.
- 2) Residential equipment must have an external disconnect within 6 ft. of the unit and the work space must not be less than thirty (30) inches wide in front of the electric equipment.
- 3) Residential and commercial outside equipment must be mounted at the same elevation as the finished floor level of the structure and must be anchored.
- 4) Residential equipment installed in an attic must have a 24" walkway for access. All mechanical equipment must have a light. No equipment shall be installed in 5' side yard set back on new construction.
- 5) Texas City Ordinance requires the return air to be sized at a minimum of 100 square inches per ton.
